General provisions of the Council of Young Scientists

- 1. The Council of Young Scientists (SMU University) unites young scientists of the NAO "South Kazakhstan State Pedagogical University" in order to support them, protect the interests of young scientists in research, educational and educational activities and the social sphere.
- 2. In accordance with the orders of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan and instructional documents, the Council of Young Scientists is the governing public body coordinating the activities of all departments of the university for the organization of research work of young scientists and students.
- 3. SMU is organized by the order of the chairman of the board Rector of SKSPU.
- 4. In its activities, SMU is guided by the Charter of the University and the specified provision.
- 5. Young scientists and specialists under the age of 35 can be members of SMU University.
- 6. For the purposes of scientific consulting, scientists of the Republic of Kazakhstan and the CIS can be involved in the activities of SMU University. SMU works closely with the Academic Council.
- 7. The members of the SMU perform their functions free of charge.
- 8. Amendments to the Regulations on SMU are made by the head of the Department for research and research work of students with a mandatory mark in the "Change Registration Sheet" (Appendix B).
- 9. Material and technical support of SMU ST RK 1158-2002 higher professional education. Meets the requirements of the material and technical base of the organization of education.
